ABOUT THE PRODUCER

Garage Wine Co. began quite literally in Pilar and Derek's garage with the intent to revive old vineyards in marginalized Chilean communities to make coveted wines. It is still a very DIY project from vineyard to bottle.

GWCo makes wines from a series of individual parcels, small lots /
bottlings of 8 -22 barrels

ABOUT THE VINEYARD

150+ year old, old-bush head vines on 1.5 hectares
Granitic alluvial soils, near the banks of Perquilauquen river.
Grower / partner Solar family.

ABOUT THE WINE

Ancestral farming by hand and horse.
Add Bagual Garnacha wine from previous vintage to a pie de
cuba and then inoculate the can with its own native yeasts.
Caps punched down by hand, pressing was strictly manual.
Aged over two winters in third use barrels

TASTING NOTES

This is a rich and layered red with plum and berry character,
spicy, floral and subtle, it has a dark ruby color, darker than most
Garnachas, earthy and organic. The palate is sinewy, with nice
acidity and the fine tannins of the Garnacha, perfectly integrated
oak and a very tasty finish.
