## ABOUT THE PRODUCER

In 1903 Lorenzo Bauzá Juan arrived in Chile from Mallorca, Spain, alone but determined to thrive in his new home. He planted fruit and began making Pisco. In 1998 the family planted vineyards in the northern Maipo Valley region of Til Til to produce table wine. Now the winemaking is helmed by Rodrigo Bauza and winemaker Natalia Poblete.

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## ABOUT THE VINEYARD

Estate grown in the Til Til region of the Maipo Valley  
Certified Organic  
Coluvial soil with traces of clay

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## ABOUT THE WINE

Presumido is Spanish for "boastful".  
Hand harvested.  
89% Carmenere, 6% Carignan, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon  
Aged 12 months in a mix of used French oak, flex cube,  
Italian Foudre, and concrete egg

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## TASTING NOTES

Deep ruby red. Abundant raspberry and cherry notes.  
Floral notes like violet petals, black pepper, and liquorish.  
Presumido manages to merge its spicy initial notes with  
smokey tobacco notes. Graphite and mineral notes come up  
which is typical of this vineyard site.
