ABOUT THE VINEYARD

Pumanque Vineyard
37 hectares at 238 m / 780 ft elevation
Masal Selection clone, Hand harvested
Granitic soil, vertical trellis, drip irrigation

ABOUT THE WINE

2019 was a warmer year than 2018 and harvest in this vineyard took place on April 15th, a week earlier than 2018
Fermented in stainless steel
4 months on the lees
Aged 10 months
French oak barrels of 225L / 2, 3, 4, and 5 uses
Unfined/unfiltered

TASTING NOTES

A delicious, classic example of Carménère: the aromatics are of blackberries, fresh herbs, black and pink pepper, cinnamon, and cloves, with light notes of tobacco and cedar. Medium in body with pleasant acidity and a persistent finish.
