150 meters - 492 feet elevation
Grafted on 100+ year old bush head Pais
Dry farmed with regenerative farming practices

ABOUT THE WINE

Hand harvested, basket press, native yeasts
2018 was a year of high temperatures and drought in the Maule
Fermented in stainless steel, 12 months on lees in oak

TASTING NOTES

Ruby red color with garnet reflections. Intense, red ripe fruits, fennel, native trees like boldo and peumo, warm and quite persistent in mouth, medium light body with great acidity.
