**ABOUT THE PRODUCER**

Garage Wine Co. began quite literally in Pilar and Derek's garage with the intent to revive old vineyards in marginalized Chilean communities to make coveted wines. It is still a very DIY project from vineyard to bottle. GWCo makes wines from a series of individual parcels, small lots / bottlings of 8 -22 barrels

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**ABOUT THE VINEYARD**

65+ year old vines, traditionally farmed by hand and horse  
Old bush-head vines, some cables mixed with Sauv Blanc  
Hand harvested, painstakingly separating Sauv Blanc in the field  
1 hectare yielding 3.3 tons per hectare

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**ABOUT THE WINE**

Fermented naturally in amphora.  
Seeds were removed when they floated to the surface but skins remained in the juice for eleven months.

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**TASTING NOTES**

Light blonde in color this wine smells of lemon, candle wax and bee pollen. In the mouth, lemon juice, candied lemon peel and a touch of bee pollen mixed with white flowers and honey (but without sweetness). Faint chalky texture and great acidity make this a mouthwatering package.
