ABOUT THE PRODUCER

Garage Wine Co. began quite literally in Pilar and Derek's garage with the intent to revive old vineyards in marginalized Chilean communities to make coveted wines. It is still a very DIY project from vineyard to bottle. GWCo makes wines from a series of individual parcels, small lots / bottlings of 8 - 22 barrels

ABOUT THE VINEYARD

Three vineyard sites: one in Truquilemu, two in Sauzal
150+ year old bush-head vine
Granite soils, sub soils have cracks that allow for root depth.
Ancestral farming by hand and horse.

ABOUT THE WINE

Harvested by hand. Naturally fermented with native yeasts.
Caps punched down by hand. Manual pressing.
The second fruit in the ferment was added when ready on top of the tank already fermenting. One continuous ferment with three picking dates.

TASTING NOTES

Darker and more serious than the majority of País out there. It has more depth and round tannins, without the rusticity, but with the character of the grape and the granite soils. Lots of fruit but with more stuffing that the locals drink it as one of their own.
