ABOUT THE PRODUCER

Down in Itata, there is a wine shed pulsing to a different beat. Juan Jose Ledesma is a winemaker with a passion for music, and wanted to combine them both in an original way. By plunging speakers into barrels as the wine ages, he hopes to create a unique wine that has been modified by the impact of the reverberations over a long period of time. The rescue of ancient varieties, such as Malbec from San Rosendo and Cinsault from Itata, has been a constant concern in recent years.

600 m elevation, 4.5 tons/ha
50+ year old vines
No irrigation, dry farmed

ABOUT THE WINE

50% Pais, 50% Cinsault
Native yeast
Fermented in stainless steel, 50% malolactic fermentation
No oak aging. Aged 2 years in bottle.
Unfined, unfiltered.

TASTING NOTES

Fresh and fruity, approachable light red. Rustic and spicy, offering a mouthful of red cherries and tangy red currants
