ABOUT THE PRODUCER

Tropa Salvaje ("Wild Herd") is an heroic gamble on Mendozan Viticulture. Oenologist José Luis Miano and Juan Pablo Michelini, a celebrated Mendozan winemaker well known for his creativity, have planted terraced vineyards in the Rhône style. Organically grown Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon, along with old vine Pedro Ximénez, form the core wines of the project. Tropa Salvaje is a tribute to the family's twin passions: thoughtful, patient winegrowing and their work in continuing the lineage of Argentina's native Criollo horses. The result is a portfolio of utterly original wines fashioned by hand that celebrates their homeland's finest attributes.

Perdriel, Lujan de Cuyo 25 year old vines 5 ha at 980 m above sea level Silty clay loam soil

ABOUT THE WINE

Hand harvested, native yeast, whole cluster press
Fermented in concrete tanks
Carbonic maceration
2 months on the lees, no bâtonnage, 6 months in bottle

TASTING NOTES

Deep color with great texture and round tannins. Strawberry notes typical from carbonic maceration. Has a young, fresh, and juicy mouth, conferring a non-traditional expression of Cabernet Sauvignon.
