ABOUT THE PRODUCER

Down in Itata, there is a wine shed pulsing to a different beat. Juan Jose Ledesma is a winemaker with a passion for music, and wanted to combine them both in an original way. By plunging speakers into barrels as the wine ages, he hopes to create a unique wine that has been modified by the impact of the reverberations over a long period of time. The rescue of ancient varieties, such as Malbec from San Rosendo and Cinsault from Itata, has been a constant concern in recent years.

ABOUT THE VINEYARD

Grower: Alvaro Señor Ledesma
250m above sea level, Pacific influences
2 ha, 3.5 tons/ha
Granitic soil until 10m
Between 50-70 year old vines
Bush head, dry farmed
No pesticides, no fertilizers

ABOUT THE WINE

Hand harvested, destemmed by hand with a Zaranda
Native yeasts, not cultured, fermentation in stainless steel
9 months on lees with vibrational battonage
by Terroir Sonoro Music in 3rd use Rauli (native) wood.
Unfined, unfiltered. Bottle aged 3 years.

TASTING NOTES

Wild berries and herbs, with a menthol undertone.
Medium bodied and long lasting taste.
