ABOUT THE PRODUCER

Down in Itata, there is a wine shed pulsing to a different beat. Juan Jose Ledesma is a winemaker with a passion for music, and wanted to combine them both in an original way. By plunging speakers into barrels as the wine ages, he hopes to create a unique wine that has been modified by the impact of the reverberations over a long period of time. The rescue of ancient varieties, such as Malbec from San Rosendo and Cinsault from Itata, has been a constant concern in recent years.

ABOUT THE VINEYARD

Grower: Alvaro Señor Ledesma
255m above sea level, Pacific influences
Granitic soil until 10m, quartz and schist
20 year old vines, dry farmed

ABOUT THE WINE

Hand harvested, destemmed by hand with a Zaranda
Native yeasts
24 hour skin contact, then pressed
Cold fermentation in stainless steel
No malolactic fermentation
2 months on the lees until bottled (with added must)
No aging, no fining, no filtering
Wine has second fermentation in bottle without disgorgement

TASTING NOTES

El Imposter is fresh and fruity, with strawberries and cherries.
In mouth it is straightforward, dry and refreshing.

10% Alcohol 3 g/l Residual Sugar
6.78 g/l Total Acidity 3.08 pH
