Granitic soil, Mediterranean climate
Sustainable farming practices
Drip irrigation, vertical trellises

ABOUT THE WINE

Clone C46 and 337
Hand harvested
4 months on lees, 10 months in barrel
French barrels - 225 liters of 2, 3, 4, and 5 use
Unfined, unfiltered

TASTING NOTES

Deep ruby in color, and highly aromatic of bright red fruit on the nose. On the palate, there is balance among the tannins, fresh acidity, juicy fruit components and measured alcohol. The texture is smooth, with concentrated red fruit and garden herbs, and a subtle presence of oak, well-integrated into the finished wine.
