## ABOUT THE PRODUCER

Garage Wine Co. began quite literally in Pilar and Derek's garage with the intent to revive old vineyards in marginalized Chilean communities to make coveted wines. It is still a very DIY project from vineyard to bottle.

GWCo makes wines from a series of individual parcels, small lots /  
bottlings of 8 -22 barrels

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## ABOUT THE VINEYARD

Alluvial soil found on the banks of the Perquilauquen river which is wide here, lending cooler conditions than neighboring regions.

Grower / partner Solar family.

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## ABOUT THE WINE

Ancestral farming by hand and horse.

Native yeasts (added Bagual wine from previous vintage to a pie de cuba)

Caps punched down by hand, pressing was strictly manual.

Aged over two winters in third use barrels

3 barrels Carignan, 2 barrels Garnacha, 1 barrel Mataró

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## TASTING NOTES

"This 2015 is a lot more powerful and has a little more ripeness, while the 2016 is fresher and more aromatic. This seems to be aromatically dominated by Carignan, and the palate reveals some earthy rusticity I also often associate with the grape. However, 2015 seems to be a quite tannic year." - LG
