ABOUT THE WINE

Hand harvested
Fermented with native yeasts in concrete eggs
6 months on the lees
Aged 8-10 months in concrete eggs
(no oak used)
Unfined, unfiltered

TASTING NOTES

Bright, ruby red color. In the nose it has high red fruit intensity, with a lot of sour cherry and mineral notes from the granite that forms the soil. In the mouth it has loads of energy layered with good acidity. It is fresh, vibrant, with soft tannins and persistent presence.
